


A cooperative partnership formed by 12 neighboring health care institutions on Hospital Hill.




Health Sciences District: By the Numbers

- + 3,300 students annually.
- + 21,000 alumni in KC and around the World.
- 15,000 Employees 3rd Largest Employer in KCMO.
- +450,000 Clinic Visits very Year
- Appx. \$30M in collective research funding



Proposed Health Sciences District CID

- Children's Mercy Hospital, UMKC, Truman Medical Center, and Ronald McDonald House are the Health Sciences District members (the "Members") that are leading the CID process.
- Each Member will have representation on the CID Board



Housing and Infrastructure Improvements

- Infrastructure Improvements: Pedestrian access and pathways, signage, landscaping, and other improvements
- Housing: Residential housing related improvements that directly improve health and quality of life. Funds allocated to Housing Improvements will be contributed to the City's Housing Trust Fund.
- Cooperative Economic Development Plan with the City

Hospital Hill Redevelopment

- Hospital Hill North Urban Redevelopment Plan.
- Children's Mercy Hospital/Hospital Hill Campus.
- University of Missouri Kansas City Expansion on Hospital Hill.
- City, County, and State Facilities on Hospital Hill
- Collaborative Planning for Future Development on Hospital Hill.

Hospital Hill Redevelopment

Two Recent Examples of Major Redevelopment

- New 9-story structure.
- 375,000 square feet, including 3,000+ linear feet of bench space for research and 140,000 square feet of shell space for future growth.
- Focusing on finding answers, diagnoses, treatments and cures for children facing rare diseases.
- Will increase CMH's dedicated research space by 5.5 times and triple the research staff.
- 400 seat auditorium will hold large national and local meetings as well as provide a creative arts and performance space.



Second Redevelopment Example

Truman Medical Center's UH2

- State of the art 79,000 square foot building
- Primary care clinics, a women's clinic, and a retail pharmacy.
- Many of the clinics will be moved from the main hospital which will allow expansion of the Neo-Natal Intensive Care Unit and add additional patient rooms in the main hospital.
- New jobs will include pharmacists, catering, concierge, and custodial workers.
- 200 new construction jobs



Benefit District

- The Project will include a defined Benefit District in which the Housing Improvement projects will be implemented.
- The Benefit District will have advisory committee which will include representatives from the neighborhoods surrounding Hospital Hill.
- The area includes both portions of the 3rd and 4th Districts.
