## **Meeting Minutes**

## Doug Jones, City Auditor

Doug Jones gave a summary of the second audit concerning short-term rentals. The report identified a need to review the permitting process and penalties for non-compliance with City ordinances.

## **Committees**

## Housing

Kate Barsotti gave a brief update on the three Short-term Rental (STR) workshops and their findings. Workshop attendees included Airbnb owners, property managers, Type 1 hosts, and neighborhood leaders.

Tiffany Moore presented the KCNAC recommendations regarding short-term rentals.

- A moratorium on new permits to give the City, hosts, and neighborhoods time to transition to a new STR program.
- Type 1 STRs allowed in an owner-occupied residence (or a designee of the owner). Notification of adjacent neighbors required.
- No Type 2 STRs in residentially zoned structures.
- An intermediary online listing service must provide the City with real-time STR data and validate the host's permit prior to posting. Each platform must collect and remit City taxes.
- Require a business license for Type 2 STRs.
- Limit STR permits to 300 citywide.
- Establish an advisory committee to evaluate applications for new permits and to respond to changes in the STR industry as needed. The committee would meet quarterly.
- No longer allow a Special Use Permit for an STR.
- All STRs must participate In the Healthy Homes program.

#### **Neighborhood Services report**

Gary Jones, Community Engagement Coordinator, said the proposed neighborhood registration platform in process and recommended a Chief Equity Officer as a presenter for the next meeting.
