2. Strategic Plan		<p>Dr. Williamson discussed the updates made to the Community Needs Assessment. Clay and Platte County HIT data was added (showing 0 for unsheltered count), but waiting on Housing Inventory County data. Other changes included a correction for the severe cost burden in terms of percentage of all renters who are extremely cost burdened.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>The Task Force voted to approve the Community Needs Assessment.</i> <p>Marqueia Watson discussed the edits on the Strategic Plan. There are still dollar amounts and data points that are needed to include in the plan, but there are some things that might not be quantifiable.</p> <p>Changes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Addition of strategies from document - Added gap between rent and wages as a root cause of homelessness - Discussed projected need for Transitional Housing - Stephanie Boyer recommended shared housing strategy - Added Longitudinal Data from Stella platform for Continuum of Care - Edited key objective in priority 1 - Increased efforts to bring more housing units online - Added leveraging current cold weather plan - Added laundry strategy to address hygiene - Added need to make more effective use of existing crisis resources - Added addressing housing instability among high-risk subpopulations (staff for youth reentry planning) - Added landlord training and education - Added Padmission Software
