Authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into a \$7,520,000.00 design and building services agreement with Radmacher Brothers Excavating, Inc., for the 63rd Street Section 1 Reconstruction, Woodland Avenue to Prospect Avenue Project; and recognizing this ordinance as having an accelerated effective date.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Radmacher Brothers Excavating, Inc., in the amount of \$7,520,000.00 for design and building services in Project No. 89008711, 63rd Street Reconstruction, Woodland Avenue to Prospect Avenue, from funds hereby and previously appropriated to the following accounts:
