Section 1. That the payment of the sum of \$67,500.00 for the settlement of claims asserted by Animashawn West in the lawsuit styled *Animashawn West v. City of Kansas City, Missouri*, Case No. 2116-CV08671, as recommended by the City Attorney and the Risk Management Committee, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Attorney is hereby authorized to pay the sum of \$67,500.00 in settlement of said claims asserted by Animashawn West in this lawsuit from funds previously appropriated in Account No. 23-7010-131545-B, City Legal Expense Fund.
