RESOLUTION NO. 220058

Directing the City Manager to ensure that any AR or policy related to COVID-19 testing applies equally to all employees, regardless of bargaining unit; and directing the City Manager to report to Council within 10 days of adoption on the status of that alignment, specific COVID-19 testing site information, and COVID-19 related expenditures.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the City Manager shall ensure that any AR or policy related to COVID-19 testing applies equally to all employees, regardless of bargaining unit.

Section 2. That the City Manager shall report back to the Council within 10 days of adoption on the status of that alignment required in Section 1, a list of third-party COVID-19 testing sites, the number of City employees tested at third-party testing sites, and a full accounting of all COVID-19 monies and expenditures by the City since March 12, 2020.
