BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Director of the Water Services Department is authorized to execute Contract No. 1693 in the amount of \$5,600,000.00 with Goodwin Bros. Construction Co., for the Buckeye Creek Pump Station Screening and I&C project, Project No. 81000727. A copy of the contract is on file in the office of Water Services.

Section 2. That the Director of the Water Services Department is authorized a maximum expenditure of \$6,160,000.00 from Account No. AL-8193-807777-611060-81000727, Sewer Pump Stations, to satisfy the cost of this contract.
