ORDINANCE NO. 230960

Approving and authorizing settlement of a lawsuit entitled *Southwestern Bell Tel. Co. v. City of Kansas City, Missouri*, Case No. 2316-CV12698.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the payment of the sum of \$75,000.00 for the settlement of claims asserted by Southwestern Bell Tel. Co. d/b/a AT&T Missouri in the lawsuit styled *Southwestern Bell Tel. Co. v. City of Kansas City, Missouri*, Case No. 2316-CV12698, as recommended by the City Attorney and the Risk Management Committee, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Attorney is hereby authorized to pay the sum of \$75,000.00 in settlement of said claims asserted by Southwestern Bell Tel. Co. d/b/a AT&T Missouri in this lawsuit from funds previously appropriated in Account No. 24-7010-131523-B-618200, Water General Liability.
