WHEREAS, the City owns rights in certain real property generally located at 5301 East 27th Street, Kansas City, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the Kansas City Police Department has determined that it has no current or future need for the property located at 5301 East 27th Street; NOW, THEREFORE;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the City Manager is directed to work with District 3 Councilmembers and others to determine a new use for City property generally located at 5301 East 27th Street, Kansas City, Missouri 64127, or, if no other use can be found, determine whether the property should be declared surplus.
