BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the revenue in the following account of the General Fund, is hereby estimated in the following amount pursuant to the Bare Essentials Home Care lease agreement:

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Section 2. That the Director of General Services Department is authorized to execute a one-year lease agreement with Bare Essentials Home Care for the purpose of the use of an office space beginning May 1, 2022 and ending April 30, 2023 with two options to renew for one year each.
