Authorizing the Director of Health to execute a professional services contract in the amount of \$75,000.00 with iBossWell for strategic business planning services for the Health Department; and authorizing the Director of Health to extend the term of the contract without further Council approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Director of Health is authorized to execute a professional services contract with iBossWell for a total contract amount not to exceed \$75,000.00, for Health Department strategic business planning for the contract period of September 1, 2022 to March 31, 2023, to be paid from funds appropriated in Account No. 23-2480-505069-B-G50506924. A copy of the contract, in substantial form, is on file with the Director of Health.

Section 2. That the Director is hereby authorized to extend the term of the iBossWell contract without further Council approval.
