Authorizing a \$4,600,000.00 design professional services contract with Burns & McDonnell Engineering Company, Inc., for Regulatory Compliance and Capital Improvement Planning Optimization.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Director of the Water Services Department is authorized to execute Contract No. 1704, in the amount of \$4,600,000.00, with Burns & McDonnell Engineering Company, Inc., for Regulatory Compliance and Capital Improvement Planning Optimization, Project No. 60810118. A copy of the contract is on file in the office of Water Services.

Section 2. That the Director of the Water Services Department is authorized to expend up to \$4,600,000.00 from Account No. 24-8110-807769-610300-60810118, Overflow Control Program, to satisfy the cost of this contract.
