### ORDINANCE NO. 230842

Sponsor: Director of the Aviation Department

Authorizing the Director of Aviation to execute a Peer-to-Peer Agreement with Turo, Inc. to provide car sharing services at Kansas City International Airport.

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Director of Aviation is hereby authorized to enter into a Peer to Peer Agreement with Turo, Inc. authorizing car sharing services in the single terminal commercial curb and parking areas at the Kansas City International Airport with a term from October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024, with five, one year renewal options. A copy of the agreement is on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

Section 2. That the revenue in the following account of the Fund 8300, Aviation Department General Fund - Other Transportation Fund, is hereby estimated in the following amount:
