RESOLUTION - Directing the City Manager to identify potential locations and potential partners in each council district for 24-hour drop boxes and other methods for more accessible payment methods to receive payment of water bills and report back within 60 days.

WHEREAS, the Water Services Department currently operates a single drop box location to receive water bill payments, located at 4800 E. 63rd Street; and

WHEREAS, the drop box location requires many residents to travel a considerable distance to make payments; and

WHEREAS, City Council believes establishing more drop box locations will benefit all residents by increasing convenience; and

WHEREAS, additional drop box locations should focus on multiple strategies for collection and prioritize locations that are accessible and close to transit facilities; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

That the City Manager is directed to identify additional locations and potential partners in each council district to operate 24-hour drop boxes and other methods for more accessible payment methods to receive water bill payments and report back to Council within 60 days.
