## ORDINANCE NO. 220075

Authorizing a \$2,946,761.00 construction contract with Gunter Construction Company, for the Baseline Improvements: Town Fork Creek project; authorizing a maximum expenditure of \$3,200,000.00; and authorizing a \$260,750.00 Design Professional Services Amendment No. 3 to Contract No. 1516 with Hg Consult, Inc. for a total contract amount of \$760,750.00.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Director of the Water Services Department is authorized to execute Contract No. 1535 in the amount of \$2,946,761.00 with Gunter Construction Company, for the Baseline Improvements: Town Fork Creek project, Project No. 81000838. Section 2. That the Director of the Water Services Department is authorized a maximum expenditure of \$3,200,000.00, from Account No. 22-8110-807769-B-81000838, Overflow Control Program, to satisfy the cost of this contract.

Section 3. That the Director of the Water Services Department is authorized to execute Design Professional Services Amendment No. 3 to Contract No. 1516 in the amount of \$260,750.00, for a total contract amount of \$760,750.00, with Hg Consult, Inc., for the Baseline Improvements: Town Fork Creek project, Project No. 81000838.
