ORDINANCE NO. 220706

Recognizing the Missouri Grind Elite 5th grade girls' basketball team for winning the AAU 5th National Championship.

WHEREAS, the Missouri Grind Elite is a 501-3c nonprofit organization that specializes in basketball skill development and game play experience for young women in the Kansas City Metropolitan and surrounding areas; and
